STREET NAME CHANGE POLICY

This Street Name Change Policy passed by the Select Board on November 10, 2022, with no changes shall supersede any previous Street Name Change Policy in place prior to this date.

STREET NAME CHANGE POLICY

1 PURPOSE

- 1.1 To outline the provisions needed by the Board of Selectmen to change a street name, be it a public or private road.

2 REQUIREMENTS

- 2.1 No personal names are allowed; unless of historical significance
- 2.2 The change must be unanimous and in writing by all property owners on the road
- 2.3 The change must not create a public safety issue
- 2.4 The change cannot conflict with any other street name
- 2.5 There shall be a fee of \$250.00 to offset the cost to the Town for changing the street name






